PARKING IN ST ANDREW'S CHURCH CAR PARK

There have been more complaints from members of St Andrew's Church regarding parking in the church car park. Parking in the church car park is for people using the facilities of the church at that time. It is required in a morning for people dropping their child off at the playgroup or the various clubs which run in church and these people are not able to park in the car park due to inconsiderate parents parking there instead. There are 3 cars who regularly park in the church car park from 2.20pm every day.

Members of the church have been in touch with the local police and have been advised to note car registration numbers and forward the information to them, as this is private land and not a public car park. If you park your car in the church car park, you are trespassing.

Parents/carers will need to find a place to park further away from school and walk the remaining distance. There is usually plenty of space to park on Huddersfield Road on the school side from Coronation Road or along Stafford Road.
